The Work

Travelling for several days from Belém to Manaus in the Amazon, Maria discovers that the rainforest is a unique ecosystem. Its special climate is home to indigenous people, plants and many fascinating animals that are only found here: agoutis, anteaters, anacondas, macaws, howler monkeys, pink river dolphins, sloths, jaguars, caiman, capuchin monkeys, hummingbirds, piranhas and toucans. The Work

The Work

A school class visits a dinosaur museum and readers can immerse themselves in the world of the gigantic animals, together with two of the children in the class.
